AAUW Scholarship for a Graduate Woman and AAUW Scholarship for an Undergraduate Woman At Northeastern State University

DEADLINE: Must be received by Monday, October 6, 2014

The Tahlequah Branch of the American Association of University Women (AAUW) has established a \$1,000 annual scholarship and one year membership in AAUW for a graduate woman, and a \$500 annual scholarship for an undergraduate woman, for use in the 2014-15 academic year at Northeastern State University.

The 100+ year old organization of AAUW promotes equity for women, education and self-development over the life span, and positive societal change.

Conditions of the scholarship are:

Graduate Woman Scholarship:

1. The Graduate Woman scholarship recipient must be pursuing a master's or doctorate degree at Northeastern State University (any NSU campus);
2. The amount of the Graduate Woman scholarship is \$1,000, to be awarded in equal amounts for the fall and spring semesters (\$500 per semester), plus a one-year membership in AAUW;
3. Applicants may be enrolled either full-time or part-time;
4. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade average of 3.5 in all graduate course work attempted. (If the applicant has no graduate course work, the undergraduate grade point average must be at least 3.0);
5. The recipient must maintain the required cumulative grade average through the fall semester after the award or the scholarship will be awarded to the alternate applicant.

Undergraduate Woman Scholarship:

1. The Undergraduate Woman scholarship recipient must be pursuing a bachelor's degree at Northeastern State University (any NSU campus).
2. The amount of the Undergraduate Woman scholarship is \$500, to be awarded in equal amounts for the fall and spring semesters (\$250 per semester);
3. Applicants may be enrolled either full-time or part-time;
4. Applicants must have a minimum cumulative grade average of 3.0 in all undergraduate course work attempted;
5. The recipient must maintain the required cumulative grade average through the fall semester after the award or the scholarship will be awarded to the alternate applicant.

Deadline and Selection/Award Process

1. Applications for this scholarship must be **RECEIVED BY MONDAY, OCTOBER 6, 2014**, with the scholarship being awarded for the current academic year (2014-15);
2. The applications will be reviewed by the AAUW Scholarship Committee for recommendation to the AAUW Board for final approval;
3. Applicants will be notified by email once a recipient has been selected and approved;
4. The recipient will be invited to a later AAUW (Tahlequah Branch) meeting in Tahlequah;
5. The recipient and applicants are encouraged to attend the AAUW meetings and/or AAUW Student Chapter meetings and events;
6. Scholarship money will be disbursed into the student's account in the fall and spring semesters after the award is made, subject to proof of enrollment;

8. Failure to include any of the materials OR failure to meet the submission deadline will cause disqualification.
