To qualify, applicants must meet the following criteria:

- 1. Have completed at least 12 hours at NSU
- 2. Have a cumulative GPA of at least 2.5
- 3. Submit no more than a two-page essay (double-spaced) describing a "particularly rough patch" you have recently encountered and specifically how and why you intend to persevere in your studies at NSU. (see website for examples)
- 4. Finalists will be asked to complete a video interview at NSU that may be used by NSU for fundraising and other purposes.
